PRESENT YOUR SOLUTION TO AN INDUSTRY CHALLENGE TO IMPROVE RAILWAY BUSINESS FOR A PLACE AT THE NATIONAL RAIL AWARDS 2015.

Entries should focus on an industry challenge that improves the railway business position through reduced costs and/or improved revenue. The idea may lead to a direct reduction in engineering costs or be an engineering-led contribution to reduced operating, maintenance or construction costs, or allow higher revenues to be secured. Ideas and products across all parts of the railway are welcome.

The judges will be looking for developments with potential significant industry impact. Innovations should be able to demonstrate a credible possibility for implementation.

This will be an evening where entrants will be required to present to an engineering judging panel and public audience at the Institution of Mechanical Engineers.

COMPETITION TIMELINE:

- Initial ideas judged and shortlisted by an industry-wide panel
- Shortlisted entries to be presented on **8 June 2015** at IMechE HQ to senior judges and audience
- The evening's winner will be recommended to the full panel of National Rail Awards judges

The winning idea will be celebrated at the National Rail Awards on 17 September in London. Attended by employers, manufacturers and investors, your idea and your company will have their profile raised and presented along with the best of industry achievers.
